Goal #1 – Student Achievement

Support student growth and academic achievement through continuous review and data analysis focused on the refinement of curriculum, instructional practices, and professional development. Increase opportunities for students to be successful by expanding our academic and intervention programs. Implement one-to-one student access to technology devices. Continue to expand online curricular components, future-ready concepts and infuse 21st Century skills in all academic areas. As measured by evidence of data analysis at school, documentation of PD/PLC sessions, data of student progress in intervention programs, and NJQSAC data.

Goal #2 – Communication and Transparency

Leverage district branding, create a visible social media presence and increase electronic and traditional methods of communication to develop and strengthen the relationship between the staff, students, parents and community. Increase transparency through collaboration with students, staff and parents at school events. Continue to highlight student achievements, school programs and extend parental outreach via multiple media platforms and enhanced usage of existing methods of parental and board communication. As measured by documentation of events at school, social media posts and community notifications to all stakeholders including board members, staff, students and parents.

Goal #3 – Facilities, Safety and Security

Maintain a safe and secure learning environment, including physical security, facility safety, physical upgrades and a reduction in the amount of violence, vandalism, harassment, intimidation, and bullying through various school-based initiatives while also decreasing the number of out-of-school suspensions. Continue to develop “Stigma Free” programs and enhance school climate from within, while leveraging state and local resources to strengthen district security. As measured by evidence of SSDS data, Realtime data, school safety/awareness programs, the continuation of facility upgrades and security updates to the school.
