

NJ Summer EBT is coming in Summer 2024.

WHAT IS SUMMER ELECTRONIC BENEFITS TRANSFER (SUMMER EBT)?

- ◆ A new-to-NJ, permanent, nationwide program
- ◆ Provides grocery benefit to children while on summer break
- ◆ \$120 per eligible child for the purchase of nutritious food

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any child aged 6-16 who is currently approved to receive NJ-SNAP, TANF, or Foster Care benefits *or*

Children aged 6-16 who attends a school that participate in the National School Lunch/School Breakfast program who have been certified as Federally eligible for free or reduced-price meals through NJ-SNAP, TANF, Foster Care, or with an approved school meal application.

CAN I STILL APPLY?

Yes! If your student attends a school that participates in the National School Lunch/School Breakfast program and does not currently receive NJ SNAP, TANF, or Foster Care benefits or have an approved application on file for School Year 2023-2024, you can submit an application through your School District to determine if you qualify as Federally Eligible. Be sure to submit your application no later than **April 19, 2024**.
