### **QUALIFICATIONS**

### **SCOPE**

Teacher will be responsible for educating secondary school students the art of acting, theater, and performance arts; develop and deliver lesson plans and activities that engage students in active learning experiences; create a curriculum that covers all aspects of theater production in accordance with NJ standards for Visual and Performing Art; evaluate student performance and make recommendations for improvement.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Teach acting skills such as voice and movement to students in a classroom setting.
- Plan, prepare, and present lessons that incorporate acting techniques to teach acting skills such as body awareness and vocal projection.
- Conduct workshops and acting classes that support students' development of acting techniques, acting methods, audition techniques, and other theater arts topics.
- Design theater productions by selecting scripts, work with directors and actors to develop character development, and plan technical elements such as lighting and sound.
- Introduce historical and contemporary theater history, and consider how each influences the development of theater arts through time.
- Guide students in exploring career paths in theater, drama, and the performing arts.
- Assist with backstage work such as building and painting sets and props, help to run rehearsals, and dress actors for their roles.
- Evaluate student progress and provide feedback on technique and performance.
- Develop curricula for theater/drama classes based on state standards and subject matter guidelines established by the school district.
