

Offered on Saturdays from January through March



Seniors who have not met any testing requirement for graduation are mandated to attend as this is their last chance to meet the requirement and graduate high school



Taught by our ELA and Math teachers in small groups for individualized attention

Non-fiction/Information texts taken from the Associated Press and other news outlets



Articles are modified for four different reading levels so teachers can assign the same article but differentiate and assign appropriate reading levels to their students



Monitors reading progress through quizzes



Students can progress to the highest reading level(actual print publication)
