

<u>COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY</u>

The commencement ceremony will begin promptly at 6:00pm on Walton Field on Friday, June 24, 2022. Seniors must report to the Farrell Gym or Schneider Auditorium by 5:15pm. Any student who is late for the procession, or who appears to be under the influence, will NOT participate in the ceremony. Disruptive behavior will result in immediate removal.

TICKETS

Each senior will receive 4 tickets: these tickets are to be used in the event of inclement weather only. There are no tickets needed for an outdoor ceremony.

4 GREEN INDOORS - IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER ONLY

IMPORTANT: Please bring the GREEN indoor tickets to commencement. In the event of inclement weather and the ceremony moves indoors, ONLY indoor GREEN tickets will be used.

DRESS AT COMMENCEMENT

Girls should wear a white/light dress or a skirt and top under the gown. Light colored shoes (white or beige) should be worn. Sandals are accepted, NO sneakers or flip flops.

Boys should wear a shirt and necktie with dress pants under the gown. Suit jackets are not to be worn under the gown. No sneakers or flip flops.

CAPS AND GOWNS

Caps and gowns will be distributed after school, outside the student activities office. They do not need to be returned. **Do not alter your cap in any way.** Take the gown out of the bag and hang it up immediately. Only Honor Societies and Scholar of Distinction medals and chords distributed by Passaic Valley High School may be worn.
