

INFORMATION SHEET

This is your information page to ensure that you are eligible to play a sport at Passaic Valley High School

- 1. Visit PVHS homepage-www.pvrhs.org
- 2. Click on Athletics
- 3. Click on Registration
- 4. Fill out all forms ONLINE
- 5. Print out MEDICAL forms
- 6. Take an IMPACT test (Directions Below)
- 7. Go to a Doctor or walk in clinic and get an updated physical
- 8. Turn in Physical to NURSE, COACH OR TRAINER
- 9. If you an upperclassman and failed any classes be sure to check with your GUIDANCE COUNSELOR about academic eligibility
- 10. COMMUNITCATE WITH YOUR COACH! Email them & get in touch with them! Find out when tryouts & practices start.

PLEASE REMEMBER

- Your parent or guardian MUST complete the online registration
- You MUST have an updated physical to be eligible
- You MUST take an IMPACT test in order to be able to play

Online Registration is the only way to register!

IMPACT TESTING

NJSIAA requires you to take this baseline test in order to play any sport.

The test is good for 2 years. Please follow the steps below.

- 1. Go to www.impacttestonline.com/schools
- 2. Type in customer code: 0MW6T2WR1H
- 3. Select "Passaic Valley High School" from the drop down box
- 4. Launch Baseline Test
- 5. When test is completed, print out confirmation page, if possible
